

Hager Preschool one of two Kentucky Preschools named Centers of Excellence



Hager Preschool has recently been recognized by the Kentucky Department of Education for achieving the designation as an Early Childhood Center of Excellence. There are only two preschool programs in Kentucky to achieve this recognition of excellence and Hager Preschool is one of those two.

Representatives from the Kentucky Department of Education visited Hager Preschool on Tuesday, Nov. 10, to present a banner and certificate to Hager Preschool Director Sherry Baber and her staff.

Hager will serve as a model preschool for other school districts in the region and throughout the Kentucky. They will mentor and share their insights and best practice experiences with fellow early childhood educators and encourage their quests for high quality environments for the children and families within their communities.

Hager Preschool serves approximately 320 at-risk 3 and 4 year-olds and is a partnership between Owensboro Public Schools and Audubon Area Head Start.
